

➤ **How is the exhibition organised?**

The exhibition is divided into four parts:

1. INFORMATION POINTS:

The FAO, the Federal Office for Agriculture, ProSpecieRara, Biodiversity Forum, Convention on Biological Diversity, Agridea, InfoAgrar, Working Committee of Swiss cattle breeder, Swiss National Stud, Freiburger Breeding Association, Swiss Goat Breeding Association, ETH-ZIL Swiss Centre for International Agriculture, Swissaid and the League for Pastoral People will present their fields of activity. Further organisations are invited to build up their information points.

2. STANDS:

At the exhibition stands, various goods such as cheese and other milk products, and dried meat can be tasted and sold. This part may include handicraft products as well.

3. COFFEE CORNER / STAGE

A place for demonstrations (e.g. cheese dairy) and specific exhibitions as well as a coffee corner (beverages and snacks, no hot meals) will be set up in the rear part of the tent.

4. CINEMA:

The cinema, where topic relevant movies will be shown, provides places for 30 – 40 people. If required, a stage can be built up.

The exhibition space in the tent is free of charge. Exhibitors should bring their own material and stands. If required, exhibition stands (1.83 x 0.76 m) could be provided free of charge.

Application deadline for exhibitors is 20 June 2007.

➤ **And where are the animals?**

Adjacent to the exhibition “Biodiversity, Food and Culture – Discover the Diversity of Farm Animals”, in front of the fantastic triumvirate of Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau, several Swiss farm animals will be exhibited in open-air enclosures on the Höhematte vis-à-vis of the conference venue. The animal show is organised in collaboration with ProSpecieRara.
